JAM 101

Jam 101 is a fun-filled class for beginners who would like to explore all styles of music and techniques without committing to a single instrument. We incorporate improvisation, free jams in a group setting, and confidence building.

Offered to: Ages 12 and under.

JAMBASSADORS

JAMBASSADORS exposes students to the "ins and outs" of being in a band, with instruction from pro musicians. We provide rehearsal gear, and lead the bands through songs and preparing for gigs. Our bands have performed at Supercrawl and Sound of Music festival. Open to singers, drummers, guitar, bass, keys and more.

> Offered to: Ages 12 - 17 with experience on an instrument.



On the last Saturday of each month, young musicians and singers take the stage and showcase their talents. Jammers can perform on their own, with friends, or with our skilled instructors. All styles and skill levels welcome

Offered to: Ages 17 and under. Show up, sign up and perform!

STRING ENSEMBLE & ORCHESTRA

Students with experience on strings, woodwinds, brass or percussion can join one of our midsized ensembles. Students learn to follow a conductor and train their ears. Being a part of any ensemble gives opportunities to meet new friends and develop teamwork skills.

> Offered to: Ages 8 - 15 with 2 years of experience reading music.

VOCAL CLASSES

Our vocal coach works with students on choosing songs, stage presence, choreography, and finding their own voice. Students also work on important aspects of singing including warming up, improving range and tone. Classes are split into contemporary or musical theatre streams.

> Offered to: Ages 6 - 15 for beginner to intermediate students.

SONGWRITING

Participants explore lyric writing, the art of composition, and personal expression through music. Students often have the opportunity to record or perform their original song at the end of the class to share with friends and family.

Our instructors develop skills in harmony. melody, rhythm and sightreading. They also build on techniques learned in their AIFEC lessons. Students are provided with an instrument and taught in groups of 4-6 students.

PRODUCTION & BEAT MAKING

Our music tech courses break down beat making and recording. Our instructors teach Ableton, and use a variety of gear including Macs, iPads. grooveboxes and drum pad controllers. Students learn to combine loops and samples to make original music from scratch.
